- 1 Sew for long periods of time? The indispensable start/stop key lets you sew with no foot control fatigue. The choice is yours.
- 2 Very unique – it's a handy stitch chart on one side. Flip it over for a clever message board to clip notes to.
- 3 Always looking for your scissors? Not anymore. Press the auto thread cut key to quickly cut both threads.
- 4 Use two large thread cones - no attachments. Ideal for twin needle sewing. A separate motor can wind a bobbin while sewing.
- 5 Need an extra hand? Use the knee lifter to raise or lower the presser foot. Great for piecing and pivoting corners.
- 6 With the quick resumption mode, you won't lose data. Turn the machine back on and the last stitch(es) sewn will be displayed.
- 7 Perfect Start angle lines are a smart alternative to either marking fabrics with a 1/4 inch seam allowance or paper piecing.
- 8 Wouldn't it be wonderful to speed through long fabric lengths at 1000 spm? Set the speed control lever.



**PROTECTIVE COVER**

At the end of the day, tidy up your space. Store accessory box, knee lifter, etc. in the 4 pockets of this attractive, sturdy, red protective cover. Slip the cover over the machine and be assured everything is kept in place.





## Long, longer, longest

Satin stitches can go the extra distance. A touch of a key stretches the result up to 5 times the original length without varying the density. This is just one more aspect of the versatility available on the Elna Q7200.
